

CCHL and CHLNet Collaboration 2026 and Beyond

Outlined below are very draft principles and delineating of responsibilities suggested by CCHL to develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between CCHL and CHLNet following the LEADS Refresh. Advice and feedback from CHLNet's Board is being sought at its July 2026 board meeting.

Organizing Principles

CCHL and CHLNet will work collaboratively on initiatives related to health leadership

1. Within this collaboration:
 - a. CHLNet's focus will be on research, including the development of evidence and evidence-based tools
 - b. CCHL's focus will be on Leadership Programming (Development/Training/Education/Conferences)
 - c. Both parties will promote LEADS, injecting it into 'everyday' language

Who Does What

More discussion needs to be given on what 'programming' might mean. CCHL and its Board's biggest issue is around CHLNet commoditizing and generating revenue from LEADS – research or otherwise that CCHL has the IP for. Outlined below is an initial table to inform an MOU.
