1. Connections being felt across Canada and globally to come together but also work together on priorities and challenges.
2. Heightened kindness and positivity being felt in the system.
3. Investing in each other.
4. More recognition of those who are working so hard under challenging circumstances.
5. Diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts in Canada.
6. Energy and optimism of new hires who have strong motivation to improve the world.
7. Availability of evidence including human-centered information to elevate the discourse and find better ways of doing things.
8. The willingness of volunteers to offer their time and efforts.
9. Technology delivering on promises.
10. Commitment by people to stay strong in these continuing times of uncertainty.

What Are Your Leadership Challenges?

1. New strategies sticking and continuing to be of positive use and outcomes.
2. Public focus on their inability to access a family doctor rather than system reform.
3. Fixing things for seniors but not thinking of the problems for the generation to come.
4. Capacity to continue at the current pace the system requires.
5. Equipping novice leaders with the necessary skills and resources to address current issues.
6. Continuing to lead despite the political implications and reduction in healthcare investment.
7. Using digital resources in a safe and risk-free way.
8. Addressing interprovincial trade barriers and ensuring information follows the patient for the highest level of care.
9. Leverage proven solutions for care system redesign.
10. Leaders build the team and employees deliver the service.
